

**ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**  
**OF**  
**NOVEMBER 10, 2008**

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on November 10, 2008 at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the roll was called as follows: Mr. Denelsbeck, Mr. Caffrey, Mr. Beady, Mrs. Kain, Mrs. Kehoe, Mr. Kelleher and Mayor Praediger.

Additions to the Agenda: Mayor Praediger has a resolution to discuss under Public Safety.

Mr. Denelsbeck made a motion to accept minutes from October 13, 2008 and October 27, 2008. All were in favor.

**Law and Planning:** Mr. Beady made a motion to accept the monthly building inspector's report. All were in favor.

Mr. Beady discussed the proposed permit fee schedule prepared by Building Inspection Underwriters, Inc. Mr. Denelsbeck had a question regarding pools, sheds etc. are these considered new construction and also regarding the zoning reviews. Mrs. Metzinger will check with Building Inspection Underwriters, Inc. to clarify.

Mr. Denelsbeck asked for public comment regarding this and there were none.

**Finance:** Mr. Caffrey made a motion to accept the monthly bills and tax collector's report. General Fund \$44,731.98; Highway Aid Fund \$2,589.61; Capital Reserve Fund \$7,886.94. Police Pension Fund \$730.94. All were in favor.

Mr. Kelleher wanted to clarify that we are going to pay Pipe Services, but we are not paying the Wexler bill. This is correct.

The budget will be discussed at the end.

**Public Service:** Mrs. Kain had nothing at this time.

**Public Safety:** Mr. Caffrey made a motion to accept the Police, Fire Marshal and Fire Company Reports. All were in favor.

Mayor Praediger discussed Resolution 2008-05. This is a resolution affirming the Borough's desire to retain the original appearance of the World War 1 Monuments marking the entrance to the Borough.

Mr. Caffrey made a motion to adopt Resolution 2008-05. The vote was taken. The vote was 6:0. Resolution 2008-05 is adopted.

Chief Leary wanted to remind everyone that the Monuments will be rededicated on Tuesday, November 11, 2008 at 3:00 p.m.

**Streets, Lights, and Sewers:** Mr. Kelleher made a motion to accept the Streets Department and Streets Opening Reports. All were in favor.

Updates: Ongoing leaf collection; the fall banners were hung; the flower baskets were taken down; the crew has also been helping with the monuments; still in the process of dealing with Wexler. Mr. Kelleher stated that the gentlemen from Wexler wanted some information regarding the map showing man hole to man hole. Per Mr. Kelleher advised that he does not want to give him any information.

**Recreation:** Mrs. Kehoe had nothing at this time. Mrs. Kehoe did advise that the Basketball Camp is starting in January. We have received one application. Mr. Casey will have to schedule an interview.

**Property:** Mr. Beady had nothing at this time.

**Personnel:** Nothing was discussed in Mr. Casey's absence.

Mayor Praediger asked if he could have the hanging baskets that were taken down to give to Mr. Dunleavy to replant in the spring. Mr. Denelsbeck advised him that the borough will be replanting them in the spring.

**Public Comment:**

Mr. Naudascher had a question regarding leaves. What is the procedure regarding someone putting their leaves in the street. Mr. Denelsbeck advised him that if he sees this, he should call Mrs. Metzinger.

The 2009 budget was discussed.

A motion was made to adjourn. All were in favor.
