

ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL
COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OF
APRIL 30, 2007

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on April 30, 2007, at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance were recited, the roll was called as follows: Mr. Denelsbeck, Mr. Beady, Mr. Kelleher, Mr. Caffrey, Mr. Casey, Mrs. Kehoe, and Mayor Costello.

Mr. Kelleher added to the agenda S. Sylvania Playground Maintenance. Mr. Casey included resignation of the assistant borough manager. Mr. Denelseck has an issue for Law and Planning.

Motion was made to adopt the agenda. All were in favor.

Law and Planning Mr. Beady motioned to have Building Inspection Underwriters appointed for one more month. All were in favor. Will decide next meeting if we will use BIU or another company. Joseph Denelsbeck asked Mr. Bresnan could we limit the height of accessory structures? Mr. Denelsbeck would like someone to motion that we restrict the height of a accessory structure to 1 story. Accessory structures being sheds and garages. Mr. Naudascher suggested instead of zoning stories limit height and feet. Impervious coverage won't matter if they are told how high they can go. Mr. Caffrey mad the motion to have solicitor review zoning ordinance to limit structure height. All were in favor.

Finance: Mr. Casey motioned to accept actuarial valuation prepared by Duda. All were in favor.

Public Service: Mrs. Kehoe had nothing to discuss at this time.

Public Safety: Mr. Caffrey had nothing to discuss at this time.

Recreation: Mr. Kelleher said outfield needs to be filled in and graded. Installers of Playset will look at field. Field should be dragged regularly; Mr. Denelsbeck would like Rockledge to maintain? Possibly purchase equipment; contact recreational engineer for drainage problem. Playset is done; wood carpet is on back order. Motion to allow nursery school to use Jarrett Playground on May 24. Rain date June 1, from 10:00am to 12:00. All were in favor. Mr. Denelsbeck asked to apply for money to plant trees. Mark Kehoe suggested a landscape architect.

Property: Mr. Beady motion to purchase patriotic banners. All were in favor.

Personnel: Mr. Casey motioned to accept resignation of assistant borough manager. Certificate of Recognition to Grace Metzinger for appreciation for outstanding contributions and dedicated service to Rockledge Borough 2004-2007. Motion to accept Joyce Hines as borough clerk. Motion accepted.
