

ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL
COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OF
July 9, 2007

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on July 9, 2007, at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the roll was called as follows: Mr. Denelsbeck, Mr. Beady, Mr. Kelleher, Mr. Caffrey, and Mrs. Kehoe, Mayor Praediger.

Personnel meeting after the meeting.

Motion was made to accept the June 11, and June 25, 2007 minutes. All were in favor.

Law & Planning: Mr. Beady made a motion to accept the monthly building inspector's report. All were in favor. Mr. Caffrey had a question about the bill for Building Inspection Underwriters. This bill was for May and it will be paid. The bill for June is on hold. Motion was made to have Joe Bresnan to have appraisals for the Church Road – Loney street plan that was adopted in 2006. We have until 2008 to use \$470,000 grant. All were in favor. Motion was made to have Mr. Hartey get specifications for the park linking. All were in favor. Motion was made for Mr. Hartey to get plans made the trail on Fox Chase Road so the trail can continue into Rockledge. This will be funded by the county. All were in favor. Mr. Denelsbeck wanted to know about the Open Space Comprehensive Plan. We have to wait 45 days before we can advertise it.

Finance: Mr. Caffrey made a motion to accept the monthly bills and tax collector's report. All were in favor.

Public Service: Mrs. Kehoe had nothing to report.

Public Safety: Mr. Caffrey made a motion to accept the Police, Fire Marshal, and Fire Company Reports. All were in favor. Mayor Praediger wanted to let everyone know that he sent a letter to the police department just to introduce himself.

Streets, Lights, and Sewers: Mr. Kelleher made a motion to accept the Streets Opening Reports. All were in favor. Mr. Kelleher wanted an update on the sewer video. We are still waiting for Rick Stoneback to get back to us. Mr. Kelleher also wanted an update on the new streets truck, Mr. Hartey advised Mr. Kelleher that he is still waiting for the state.

Property: Nothing to report.

Personnel: Personnel issue will be discussed after the meeting.

John Wynn wanted to know if something could be done for Mr. Brian Corrigan helped to plant the tree at the playground. He advised that Brian donated his time that would of cost about \$700.00.
