COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

July 30, 2007

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on July 30, 2007, at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance were recited, the roll was called as follows: Mr. Denelsbeck, Mrs. Walz, Mr. Beady, Mr. Casey, Mrs. Kehoe, and Mayor Praediger.

Motion was made to adopt the agenda. All were in favor.

Law and Planning: Two bids were opened for the 45 decorative streetlights and fixtures. Billows Electric supply was lowest bit. Motion was made to accept Billows Electric Supply bid of \$83,520.00. All were in favor. Spring City Electric was the other bidder and their bid was \$98,730.00.
