

ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL
COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OF
November 26, 2007

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on November 26, 2007, at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance were recited, the roll was called as follows: Mrs. Walz, Mr. Kelleher, Mr. Caffrey, Mr. Casey. Motion was made to adopt the agenda. All were in favor.

Law and Planning: Mr. Kelleher had nothing at this time.

Finance: Mr. Casey had nothing at this time.

Public Service: Opened 2 trash bids. One from Solid Waste doing business as J.P. Mascaro the other bid received from BFI doing business as Allied Waste. Mrs. Walz read and compared the numbers. No decision will be made tonight. Council will make a decision at the December 10, 2007 meeting.

Public Safety: Mr. Caffrey had nothing at this time.

Streets, Lights, and Sewers: Opened 4 truck bids. 1st bid: James Goodwin, \$1,922.00; 2nd bid: Modern Classics, \$4,188.00; 3rd bid: Leland Vollman, \$4,510.00; 4th bid: Mike Granieri Lawn Care Inc., \$10,000.00. Motion was made to award the bid to Mike Granieri. If he does not take delivery, we will re-bid. All were in favor.

Mr. Kelleher gave some updates: Winterized Jarrett Playground and South Sylvania Playground. Reflective Stripe has been put on the new truck. Leaves are being picked up. The vehicles are all ready for the winter. The gator has been delivered. The crew is checking the sewers. Mr. Hartey advised that he is working on getting the VHS tapes put on DVD's. When this is done Mr. Hartey, Clint Snyder and Mr. Stoneback will look over the DVD's and decide what work needs to be done.

Mr. Kelleher also had a question about the permits. Mr. Hartey advised that Bob Beady has the entire file with the updated information. Mr. Beady e-mailed Mr. Kelleher about meeting with him to discuss the permits.

Chief Leary spoke with Mr. Kelleher about the snow procedure. Mr. Kelleher advised Chief Leary that the procedure will not change.

Recreation: Mr. Casey had nothing at this time.

Property: Mr. Casey had nothing at this time.

Personnel: Mr. Casey advised that he will be interviewing the applicants for the basketball program. Council will make a decision to hire at their December 10, 2007 meeting.

Public Comment:

Mr. Kirby just wanted to say what great jobs the streets crew was doing with the yard waste pick up on Mondays.

Mr. Caffrey asked Mr. Hartey if he has seen the concrete work being done. There are some cracks in the new concrete. Mr. Hartey advised Mr. Caffrey that they will be fixed.

Mr. Hartey advised that he would like to buy wreaths and garland for the new streetlights. It will cost about \$1500.00. Mr. Caffrey suggested running this by Mr. Denelsbeck.

Mr. Naudascher had a question about the handicapped ramps in front of Siweks hardware store. Mr. Hartey advised him that that is the way PennDot completed them.

Motion was made to adjourn. All were in favor.
