

ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL
COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
OF
January 25, 2010

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on January 25, 2010 at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance were recited, the roll was called as follows: Mr. Casey, Mrs. Kain, Mrs. Kehoe, Mr. Praediger, Mr. Showmaker and Mayor Praediger.

Additions: None

Law and Planning: Mrs. Kain advised that PECO will be out during the 2nd quarter of 2010 to do tree trimming work.

Finance: Mr. Showmaker had nothing at this time.

Public Service: Mr. Praediger had nothing at this time.

Public Safety: Mrs. Kehoe had nothing at this time.

Mayor Praediger had nothing at this time.

Sergeant Miller advised that there were 19 stop sign violations, 55 other citations were written for a total of 74; 5 parking, 2 borough ordinance and 2 non traffic citations were written. Sergeant Miller also advised that the Town Watch meeting that was held at the Fire House was a success. There were about 40 people that attended.

Sergeant Miller advised that Officers Pokorny and Wade will be enrolled in accident investigation training later in February.

Mr. Casey asked if Officer Lukashunas is the officer that does the truck stops. Sergeant Miller advised that yes, he is our Federal MCSAP. He does all of our truck stops, safety inspections, etc.

Mrs. Kehoe asked who the other officer was that is going to the accident investigation training. Sergeant Miller advised her that it is Officer Leigh-Ann Wade and Matt Pokorny.

Public Works/Property: Mr. Praediger advised that there are a few items that need to be addressed in the men's bathroom at the borough hall. Mr. Praediger stated that since the last meeting everything has been taken care of.

Mr. Casey advised that the new streets crew foreman, Mr. John Hopper will be starting on February 1, 2010.

Mr. Casey advised that there is already a list of items for Mr. Hopper to take care of at the police station.

Streets Department Updates:

Mr. Clint Snyder gave the updates:

- The leaf box was put away.

- The pile of leaves that were at S. Sylvania has been taken care of.
- The "Rolling thru stop signs" were hung at Abington and Park and Abington and Sylvania.
- Repaired a couple minor leaks in the bathrooms. One in the ladies room and one in the men's room.
- Cleaned all the vehicles.
- Cleaned Rockledge Park of sticks and leaves.
- Cleaned up the shop.
- Repaired banners.
- Placed a temporary box over the light that was knocked down new Church Road.
- Serviced the generator at the Police Department.
- Picked up 12 loads of trees and yard waste during the last two weeks.

Mr. Casey asked Mr. Snyder if the markings were still on the S. Sylvania field. Mr. Snyder advised that they were there as of Saturday.

Mr. Kirby asked about the island at Church Road. He wanted to know whose idea that was. He said it does not look nice. Mr. Casey advised that it was put in there for traffic calming. Mr. Kirby was concerned about the snow plows going along the pike. Mayor Praediger advised Mr. Kirby that during the last storm there were no issues. Mr. Praediger advised Mr. Kirby that another reason that it does not look nice is that it is the winter.

Recreation: Mrs. Kehoe made a motion to have Applewood Enterprises paint the gym for their base bid of \$9,975.00. All were in favor.

Mrs. Kehoe wanted to say that the basketball camp is going fine. There is an average of 10-11 kids every day.

Personnel: Mrs. Kehoe had nothing at this time.

Managers Report:

Public Comment: Mr. Goldberg stated that he read an article regarding PECO doing their tree trimming work. He said that PECO is supposed to notify the residents in the immediate area of where they are doing their trimming. He would ask council to keep this in mind if anyone has a problem or questions about the trimming.

A motion was made to adjourn to an executive session for a personnel issue. All were in favor.
